

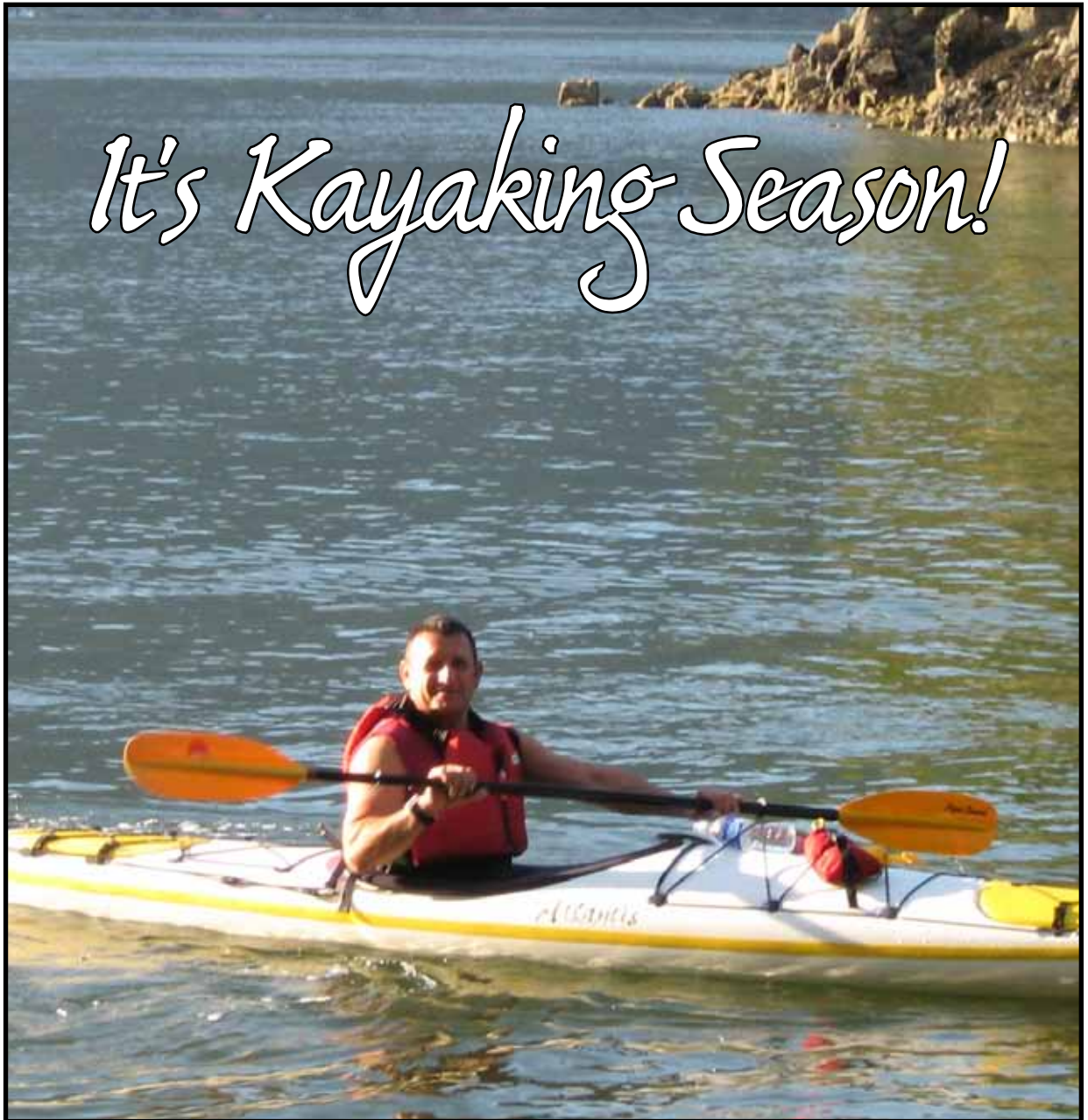

Once payment is made your space will be confirmed. Remember to get the cabin code!

Saturday night only stays are made on availability and confirmed on the preceding Wednesday.

Cancellation Policy:

- Refunds for cabin stays will be made with 48 hours advanced notice. Credits will be made to accounts.
- Payments for all dinners will be made directly to the 'chef du weekend'. Dinners that are booked and not attended will still be paid for. Cancellations after the Thursday before the dinner, must be paid for by the member, unless the member can find someone else to take their reservation.

Whistler Cabin Parking:

There is parking in front of the cabin. To maximize space and to ensure everyone has a spot, please park as close to the cabin and each other as possible. There is street parking only on the EVEN numbered side of the street (the cabin side) outside of regular office hours (Mon - Fri 9 - 6). Cars that are illegally parked will be ticketed and towed by the Whistler municipality.

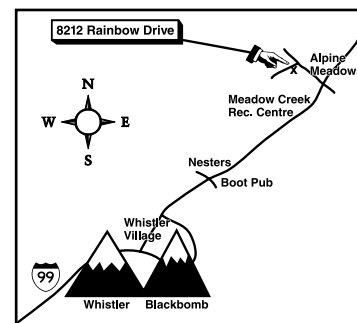
How do I get there?

Whistler, BC (*We're in Alpine Meadows*)

- Drive north on Highway 99.
- Alpine Meadows is approx. 4 Km past Whistler village.
- Once you reach the light at Alpine Meadows, turn left.
- At the stop sign, turn left again onto Rainbow Drive.
- The cabin is the first one on the left.
- There is plenty of room in the parking lot.



PSC's Payment & Refund Policy

To pay for an event (ie: dance, ski trips, OK's, etc.), all members can pay by cash, cheque, Visa or Mastercard. The Executive recommends payment by cheque because:

1. Cheques do not incur service charges.
2. Credit cards incur service charges (the club is charged 2.05% for Visa, 3.35% for M/C with 15 cents per transaction).
3. We recommend non-members pay by cash or credit card.
4. NSF cheques will be subject to the bank's service charge.

The Treasurer will make sure your cheque will be processed within a month. Cash for smaller events such as dances, pub crawl, etc. is highly recommended.

- * Please contact the organizer of the event for payment process.
- * A non-refundable deposit may be required for some events & trips. Check with the organizer.
- * Any cancellations must be made prior to the deadline cause you may or may not receive a refund. Check with the organizer.
- * No refund after the event unless other arrangements have been made. Check with the organizer.

This policy ensures the Pacific Ski Club sustains a sound financial portfolio.

Membership Fee Motion

For the past couple of decades, the Club has had a two-tier membership rate: one rate for single people and one rate for couples. The rationale behind the difference in rates goes back to when the Club sent out the BootPress via regular mail. With a couples membership, only one BootPress was mailed out each month to the couple.

Technology has moved forward dramatically over the last ten years and in fact for over the past 5 years, the Club has stopped mailing the BootPress except to those few individuals who still request a paper copy (less than 25 members). As a result of this, the Executive decided to evaluate whether it made sense to continue to offer two rates, since there were no additional cost savings for the Club by having a couple sign up together.

Currently, couples pay \$95 per year and singles pay \$60; renewal rates are \$90 for couples and \$55 for singles.

In recognition of the long standing tradition of having two rates the Executive had an extensive discussion about how to make the rates fair for both groups. Currently approximately 30% of members pay the couples rate. Given that the cost savings of a couples membership is no longer valid, the executive is proposing we move to a single fee for everyone, with new members joining at \$60/year and renewals at \$50/year. For those members who currently have a couples membership, the Executive is proposing that they be allowed to continue to pay the current renewal rate for couples. However, should they allow their membership to lapse (ie. they do not renew it before it expires) they will need to renew at the singles rate. To that end, the following motion is being presented to the membership at the June AGM:

That membership rates be set at \$60/year for new members and \$50/year for renewal and that all existing couple rates be grandfathered at the current rate until the couple allows their membership to lapse. Once a couple's membership has lapsed, both members will be required to join as individuals.

Membership Contest

Your 2010/11 Executive is committed to increasing our membership. Our target is to have 200 members by the AGM. To encourage everyone to get their friends to join, we are having a contest. Thanks to one of our new sponsors, Coal Harbour Liquor Stores, the prize is a \$500 bottle of booze.

So how do you win this fabulous prize...it is really simple – you just need to get your name into the draw...and here is how you do that:

1. For every club night you come to between now and June 2011, your name will be entered into the draw.
2. For every guest you bring to club night between now and June 2011, your name will be entered into the draw.
3. For every guest you bring to club night, who joins at club night, between now and June 2011, your name will be entered into the draw.

So that's three chances every month to get your name into the draw – do the math and your name could be in as many times as you have friends.

So what's in it for your friend to come – well, as soon as they sign up to be members, their name goes in the draw as well. So if they come out in November and sign up at the November club night, their name will go in the draw and your name will go in 3 times (one for you, one for your guest and one for turning your guest into a member).

What's the catchonly one small one...the draw will be done at the AGM and you have to be there to win!

PSC General Payment and Refund Policy

1. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard, unless otherwise stipulated.
2. There will be a service charge of \$20.00 for dishonoured cheques. A dishonoured cheque will be treated as a payment not made and appropriate missed deadline penalties will be imposed.
3. All deposits are non-refundable unless otherwise stated. Check the newsletter or ask the event coordinator for details.
4. Telephone reservations require payment by Visa or Mastercard.
5. Post dated cheques or pre-approval to debit your Visa/Mastercard may be required for the balance of payment.
6. Refunds (less the non-refundable deposit if applicable) will be granted as follows:
 - a) The coordinator is notified of cancellation a minimum of 1 week before activity/event. Trips may require more notice.
 - b) There is a death or serious illness in the immediate family.
 - c) The participant falls seriously ill.
7. Refunds will be in the form of a PSC credit voucher, which can be applied toward any PSC tour, activity, event, cabin membership etc. The credit voucher will expire 1 year from the date of issue and is nontransferable.
8. Credit vouchers may be given even if we are able to fill your spot for the activity. The participant will make an effort to find a suitable replacement.
9. "No shows" or poor weather do not constitute an adequate reason for refund.

Obligation of Membership and Waiver of Liability

Members must be 19 years of age or older

As a member of the Pacific Ski Club, I hereby agree to abide by the constitution, bylaws and regulations as set forth from time to time by the Executive.
